

**MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT FOR TEMPORARY HOLDING TANK**

Title 25, Chapter 73, Section 73.11(b) states: “A structure may not be occupied before the sewage system is finally inspected, approved and covered. Except when the sewage enforcement officer requires a change to the installation schedule because of weather and soil conditions, the permit may be modified with conditions to be established by the local agency to allow use of a septic tank as a temporary holding tank.”

Therefore, I, \_\_\_\_\_, owner of the property at \_\_\_\_\_ do agree to contract with \_\_\_\_\_, septage hauler, to pump out the accumulated liquid and solid waste and dispose of this material at \_\_\_\_\_ which is an approved disposal site recognized by the Department of Environmental Protection. Disposal vouchers must be submitted to the Sewage Enforcement Officer at the Lebanon County Planning Department within five (5) days of unloading the liquid/solids to demonstrate compliance with this agreement.

**Failure to comply with the above conditions will result in revocation of this agreement and nullification of the authorization to utilize a temporary holding tank.**
