

NOTICE OF GENERAL PRIMARY ELECTION

In accordance with the provisions of the Pennsylvania Election Code, notice is hereby given that a General Primary Election will be held in Lebanon County, Pennsylvania, between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 8:00 P.M. on the 18th day of May, 2010, at the regular places of the voting districts in and for said county.

THE PUBLIC OFFICES FOR WHICH CANDIDATES ARE TO BE NOMINATED ARE AS FOLLOWS:

One United States Senator, One Governor, One Lieutenant Governor, One Representative in Congress (17th District), One Senator in the General Assembly (48th District), One Representative in the General Assembly (101st District), and One Representative in the General Assembly (102nd District).

THE PARTY OFFICES FOR WHICH CANDIDATES ARE TO BE ELECTED ARE AS FOLLOWS:

Two Members of Democratic State Committee (One male and one female), Three Members of Republican State Committee (Not more than two members shall be of the same gender), Three Members of Democratic County Committee from each election district, and Three Members of Republican County Committee from each election district (Not more than two members shall be of the same gender).

Petitions may not be circulated prior to February 16 and are due to the appropriate governing body no later than March 9. The casting of lots for ballot position for county committee will be held on Monday, March 15 at 10:00 A.M. in the Office of the Lebanon County Commissioners (Room 207 of the Lebanon Municipal Building).
