AND NOW, this _____ day of _____, 2017, you are placed under the supervision of the Lebanon County Probation Services Department by the Honorable _____
The following conditions have been incorporated into a court order. Failure to comply with the conditions of supervision may result in an appearance before the Court.

Community Protection Conditions:

- 1) Follow all instructions of your Probation Officer and report in writing, by phone and/or in person as directed by your Probation Officer.
- 2) You shall obey all laws and remain crime free. Immediately inform your Probation Officer of any contact with Police Officers, District Magistrates, or any other law enforcement personnel.
- 3) Your curfew is _____ pm to _____ am. During these times, you shall remain inside your approved residence(s) unless you are with a parent, are working or attending a pre-approved school/church function.
- 4) You may not leave the County of Lebanon for overnight travel, unless you are in the company of a parent and have received prior permission from your Probation Officer.
- 5) You may not possess any prohibitive offensive weapons (ex. Guns, air-rifles, knives).
- 6) You are subject to the search of your person and/or residence in the event your Probation Officer has reasonable suspicion to believe you are in possession of contraband, such as: illegal drug paraphernalia, alcohol, weapons or stolen items. Any contraband found as a result of said search will be seized and disposed of accordingly.

Competency Development Conditions:

- 7) You must attend school regularly and adhere to all rules, regulations and restrictions established at the school you attend. Failure to adhere to your school district policies can result in a Probation Violation; if you are of the legal age of 17 and have withdrawn from school you shall be employed on a full-time basis.

You and your parents are required to share information between the Lebanon County Probation Services Department and _____ School District. The School District shall maintain strict confidentiality of all information received from the Juvenile Division of the County Probation Services Department; the school may not discipline you as a consequence of information it learns from the Probation Department.

Accountability Conditions:

- 8) You may not possess/drink alcoholic beverages nor use any narcotic drugs and you will abstain from the possession, use or abuse, manufacturing, or sale of any legal or illegal mind/mood altering drugs/substances, including but not limited to synthetic drugs. You shall submit to random urine testing at the direction of your Probation Officer. A refusal to submit to a urine test will be considered a failure to comply with conditions. A positive urine may result in referral for a drug/alcohol evaluation and completion of any/all recommended treatment.
- 9) You are immediately subject to electronic monitoring and/or house arrest as per order of court. This restriction is suspended based upon your ability to comply with all court ordered conditions of supervision. You shall be subject to electronic monitoring and/or house arrest at the discretion of the Juvenile Probation Unit if at any time you are determined to be non-compliant with your court ordered conditions of supervision. You shall be charged a \$6.00 per day assessment fee in the event house arrest with electronic monitoring is required.
- 10) You shall notify your Probation Officer immediately of any changes related to your address, phone number, employment, school, securing a driver's permit or license, or purchasing a car.
- 11) You shall not associate with any other person whom you know to be convicted of a crime, charged with a criminal offense or delinquent act, or under supervision by any Adult or Juvenile Probation authority.
- 12) You shall pay a Monthly Service Fee of **\$25/month** to the Lebanon County Probation Services Department.
- 13) Failure to pay Court ordered fees, costs or restitution may be brought to the attention of the Juvenile Court Judge; failure to pay as directed may result in a Court hearing and possible revocation of your community-based supervision.

Special Conditions:

You shall remain in the home of your parents or guardian; however, the Court has assigned a Probation Officer who will assist in your supervision. Juvenile Probation is designed to assist in your rehabilitation as well as hold you accountable for your behavior. The Probation Department must have the full cooperation of both you and your parents/guardian with respect to insuring your compliance with all conditions. Be advised the Lebanon Juvenile Court and the Juvenile Probation Division are authorized to take the appropriate steps necessary to protect the community from those who are deemed a danger to society.

I hereby acknowledge I have carefully read and/or have had read to me the above conditions of supervision and a copy of the same has been provided to me.
