VOTER INFORMATION

In accordance with the law, notice is hereby given that on Wednesday, June 3, 2020 at 9:00 A.M., in the auditorium of the Lebanon County Municipal Building, the computation and canvassing of the returns of the General Primary Election held on June 2, 2020, will publicly commence and will continue in the manner provided by law. Any petition to challenge the absentee or mail-in applications or ballots shall be filed no later than 5:00 p.m. on Friday, May 29, 2020. Any petition to challenge the results shall be filed no later than five (5) days after the completion of the computational canvassing of all the returns of the county by the County Board of Elections.

ABSENTEE/MAIL-IN BALLOT DEADLINE

Applications for a civilian absentee and mail-in ballots must be received in the Voter Registration Office, Room 209, Municipal Building, Lebanon PA, 17042 by 5:00 P.M. on Tuesday, May 26, 2020. POSTMARKS NOT ACCEPTED. The voted ballot must be **received** in this same office by 8:00 P.M. on Tuesday, June 2, 2020. If an elector has been issued an absentee or mail-in ballot they must complete that ballot and turn it into the Board of Elections by the June 2nd deadline. You no longer can void your ballot at the precinct and no absentee or mail-in ballots will be accepted at the precinct (polling place).

EMERGENCY VOTING

If a qualified elector becomes ill or is called away on business or duties which fact was not known prior to the absentee ballot application deadline of May 26, 2020, he or she is entitled to complete and submit an Emergency Absentee Ballot Application. Call (717) 228-4428 to inquire.

GRANTING OF ASSISTANCE

Although there will be an ADA touch screen unit at each polling precinct; a voter is still entitled to request assistance if it is so marked in the poll book or if he or she completes a declaration of assistance at the polling precinct. Anyone except an employer, a union representative, or a judge of election may assist the elector.

REGISTRATION STATUS

If you want to check on your voter registration status or your polling place, you can call the Voter Registration Office at (717) 228-4428 weekdays from 8:30 A.M. to 4:30 P.M. or visit www.votespa.com. You may also go the Lebanon County website at www.lebcounty.org under the departments tab, Voter Registration or click on Find Where to Vote on the main page. PROVISIONAL BALLOTS

Federal and State law provide voters with the opportunity to cast a provisional ballot under certain circumstances. County election officials will examine the provisional ballots within seven days after an election to determine if the individual voting that ballot was entitled to vote at the election district in the election.

YOU ARE ELIGIBLE TO CAST A PROVISIONAL BALLOT:

- If you feel you are registered to vote in a certain election district, but your name does not appear in the poll book and election officials cannot determine your registration
- If you do NOT have the proper form of identification when you appear to vote for the first time or the first time in a precinct
- If you are not registered in the political party of which you claim to be registered.
- If your absentee/mail-in ballot was **NOT** received by the County Board of Elections

COMPLAINTS

Federal and State law provides voters with the opportunity to file a complaint based on the belief that a state or local elections official or employee has violated the provisions of Title III of the federal Help America Vote Act of 2002. If you believe election officials have failed to comply with this act, you can access the Notice and Statement of Complaint by visiting www.dos.pa.gov and select File A Complaint.
