

Official Notice of Election for Military and Overseas Voters
County of Lebanon
2021 Municipal Election (November 2, 2021)

This is an official notice of an election to be conducted on November 2, 2021, in Lebanon County. You may register to vote and request an official absentee ballot by using the Federal Postcard Application (FPCA), available at www.votespa.com or www.fvap.gov. You may apply for an absentee ballot by submitting your FPCA by fax to (717) 675-2669, or by email to manderson@lebcnty.org.

You may request an absentee ballot from this office at any time prior to a primary or election. However, if time does not permit you to receive and return an official absentee ballot, you are also entitled to vote using the Federal Write-in Absentee Ballot (FWAB). Military electors may also use the FWAB to register to vote and vote simultaneously.

You may use the FWAB to vote for a candidate for U.S. Representative (Representative in Congress) as well as candidates for all state and local offices, and ballot initiatives.

To vote, refer to page 3 of the FWAB.

To vote for President of the United States and U.S. Representative (Representative in Congress), write in the name of the candidate of your choice in the space provided on the FWAB.

To vote for state and local offices or for ballot initiatives, write the names of candidates or ballot initiatives in the Addendum section of the FWAB. Under the **Office/Ballot Initiative** heading, enter the office the candidate is running for or the title of the Ballot Initiative (referendum). Under the **Candidate Name, Party Affiliation or Initiative Vote** heading, list the name of the candidate you wish to vote for, or if you are voting on a Referendum question write “yes” or “no.”

JUSTICE OF THE SUPREME COURT – Vote for One – All precincts in Lebanon County

JUDGE OF THE SUPERIOR COURT – Vote for One – All precincts in Lebanon County

JUDGE OF THE COMMONWEALTH COURT – Vote for Two – All precincts in Lebanon County

DISTRICT ATTORNEY – Vote for One – All precincts within Lebanon County

SHERIFF – Vote for One – All precincts within Lebanon County

MAGISTERIAL DISTRICT JUDGE – District 52-2-01 – Vote for One – Lebanon City wards 04, 05, 08, 09, and 10.

MAGISTERIAL DISTRICT JUDGE – District 52-2-01 – Vote for One – Cleona Borough and the Townships of Annville, East Hanover, North Annville, South Annville, and Union

MAYOR – Vote for One – All Lebanon City Wards

CITY COUNCIL MEMBERS – Vote for Two (4 year term) – All Lebanon City Wards

CITY COUNCIL MEMBERS – Vote for Two (2 year term) – All Lebanon City Wards

CONSTABLE – Vote for One – All Lebanon City Wards except the 7th Ward, and all boroughs and townships except North Lebanon and West Lebanon.

SCHOOL DIRECTOR(S) – Vote for Four – All school districts in Lebanon County

BOROUGHES (CLEONA, CORNWALL, JONESTOWN, MT. GREтна, MYERSTOWN, PALMYRA, RICHLAND)

One Mayor in all boroughs; Three Council members in Cleona, Mt. Gretna, and Richland; Four Council members in Cornwall, Myerstown, and Palmyra; Five Council members in Jonestown; Once Council member in Jonestown, Myerstown, and Richland; One Tax Collector in each borough.

FIRST CLASS TOWNSHIPS (ANNVILLE, WEST LEBANON)

Three Township Commissioners in each First Class Township

SECOND CLASS TOWNSHIPS (BETHEL, EAST HANOVER, HEIDELBERG, JACKSON, MILLCREEK, NORTH ANNVILLE, NORTH CORNWALL, NORTH LEBANON, NORTH LONDONDERRY, SOUTH ANNVILLE, SOUTH LEBANON, SOUTH LONDONDERRY, SWATARA, UNION, WEST CORNWALL)

One Supervisor in each Second Class Township; One Auditor in each township; One Auditor (4 year term) in Bethel, North Lebanon, South Lebanon, South Londonderry; One Tax Collector in each township.

ELECTION OFFICERS

One Judge of Election and One Inspector of Election in each voting district

Official Federal Write-in Absentee Ballot

Vote by writing the name and/or party affiliation of the candidate for whom you wish to vote. Some States allow the Federal Write-In Absentee Ballot to be used by military and overseas voters in elections other than general elections or for offices other than Federal offices. Consult the Voting Assistance Guide to determine your State's policy.
