 5. Good of the Order
 - a. Jo Ellen Litz –
 - i. Continue catching and killing Lantern Flies.

- ii. The mask-up campaign is offering \$1,000 grants to businesses and non-profits for displaying a sign for the campaign.  - iii. Mail-in ballots are being mailed out this week. If you don't receive your ballot you can go to Voter Registration office and get your ballot on the spot and vote at that time.
- b. Brittany Hilton – on Saturday 3-5pm there is a Black Lives Matters march and rally which is student led. They are meeting at LVC on the corner in Annville
- c. Nikki Mauer –
 - i. Advanced Care Planning presentation is available virtually. You can find information on the Community Health page for dates that the presentation is available. This is a cooperative effort between 5 hospitals.
 - ii. Teen Pregnancy Prevention program received a grant this year that works with fathers. There will be a virtual event, with a special take home gift for the first 24 people that sign up.
 - iii. The Bike Park is officially open at Coleman Memorial Park. Take time to stop out and visit and encourage families to check it out. There is also talks about possibly adding a trail around the park that is a beginner's mountain bike trail. There is a survey that Coleman Memorial Park has on their website right now. It was recommended to work with the conservation department about erosion and storm water planning.
 - iv. A large grant was received and Nikki and Ali are working together to disperse the money.
 - 1. Bring a mobile trauma unit to the community very soon.
 - 2. Bringing EMDR certification to the county – there are only about 3 therapists in the county at this time that are certified in this.
 - 3. They have hired a Therapist Coordinator who will be creating 4 mini coalitions.
 - 4. They will be looking for volunteers to help bring this to the community.
